## Portrait Workshop - 2021

*"My favorite subject to paint and teach, is portraits. Painting portraits is my greatest source of artistic pleasure and fun, yet many very fine artists shy away from them. Unrealistic expectations and a "fear of failure" prevent them from even trying."*

In this workshop, students will learn to truly *see* the unique qualities of their subjects by discerning the planes and proportions of the face. They will learn a drawing technique for easily capturing a subject's likeness... one does NOT have to be good at drawing to be good at portrait painting! Finally, students will learn how to expressively apply colors that bring life and personality to their paintings.

*The goal of this workshop is to help watercolor artists conquer their fear of painting portraits and learn to paint "fearless portraits" instead.*
